
JOIN AN EVENT

ABOUT ESN AISBL

The Erasmus Student Network is a student organisation that spreads all over Europe with 533 sections in 43 different countries. This makes it the biggest student organisation in Europe. Established on October 16, 1989, ESN is focused on supporting and developing student exchange. ESN offers services to around 350,000 students a year, organised by around 15,000 active members. The organisation tries to make the European educational environment more mobile and flexible. We do this by representing the rights of (international) students, providing information about mobility programmes, motivating students to go abroad and much more. ESN offers help to full-degree and exchange students in the academic, social and practical integration process, mainly through activities.
