

Chinese

Be successful in China

Good cooperation starts with understanding each other. Since China has become a major player on the international market, learning basic Chinese will make you more successful in doing business with Chinese people. We offer courses for daily conversation Chinese at beginners level. You will be prepared to take the exams on HSK 1 or HSK 2 level. HSK is the so- called level exam of China. Because we cooperate with the Groningen Confucius Institute you will also have the opportunity to go on a Summer Camp to the Communication University of China in Beijing after taking 40 hours of studying Chinese Language, which is two periods of lessons.

These courses cater to students with a lower B1 proficiency level and focus on enhancing all four key language skills: reading, listening, writing, and speaking. The primary objectives of these courses include expanding your vocabulary, refreshing your understanding of fundamental English grammar concepts, and providing opportunities to practise reading and speaking. By enrolling in these courses, you can work towards improving your overall English proficiency and developing effective communication skills for various everyday situations.
