This ECTS Grading Table of the School of Communication, Media & IT is based on all numerical test results obtained by students in the main phase (excluding the first year) of the Bachelor degree programmes of this school between 1 September 2020 – 1 September 2023. The numerical test results represent 89.77 % of all test results awarded to students of this school in the abovementioned period.

In the Dutch grading system, 5.5 is the lowest pass grade and 10 is the highest possible grade.
