This ECTS Grading Table of the Institute of Engineering is based on all numerical test results obtained by students in the main phase (excluding the first year) of the Bachelor degree programmes of this school between 1 September 2020 and 1 September 2023.

The numerical test results represent 84.07 % of all test results awarded to students of this school in the abovementioned period.

In the Dutch grading system, 5.5 is the lowest pass grade and 10 is the highest possible grade.
